5. Why does the author of 1 Kings reiterate the depth of Ahab's sin before presenting his humility?
6. Does such sorrow automatically equal saving faith? (Hebrews 12:14-17)
7. Why is the Lord pleased with repentance? Does your life evidence such a response to sin? (Psalm 51/ Matthew 4:17)
