5. Look up the word translated "tutor." (It means something slightly different than what we mean by a tutor today.) How does understanding this word well help illustrate the role of the Law?
6. What is symbolized by our baptism in Christ? (Romans 6:1-7) How does this passage help us see what is meant by being clothed in Christ too?
7. Some see Galatians 3:28 as reversing passages that speak to men only being elders, and even some claim this passage as a defense for homosexuality. How would you answer a person who claimed either view from this passage?
