3. How do the analogies of soldier, athlete and farmer illustrate discipleship? What parallels can you see?
4. Why do you think Paul would simply tell Timothy to pray and ponder his instruction, instead of simply giving more instruction in this area?
5. How does this passage call you to cherish the gospel more?
6. How does this urge you to guard the gospel personally and as a church body?
7. How does this passage spur you toward passing the gospel gift on to others?
