

1. Did you know the word for “basket” is the same Hebrew word translated “ark” in Genesis 6? How are the ark and Moses’ basket similar?

2. How does God’s provision for Moses’ family go above and beyond simply allowing Moses to survive? How are these benefits a celebration of God’s grace?

3. How is Moses viewed by others while living in Egypt? How is he viewed by the daughters of Ruel? How could this cause a tension for Moses as he considers his identity?

4. How old do you think Moses was when he fled Egypt? Now, look to Acts 7 and see. Was your perception different? If so, why do you think it was?

5. Which elements of the redemptive story (creation, fall, redemption, restoration) are visible in this chapter?

6. How does this chapter inform the way you should view and reach out to the world around you?

7. What challenge or encouragement did this passage provide to your soul?
