3. What gospel parallels can you find to the parting of the Red Sea?
  
4. How does Pharaoh's repeated responses show the danger of partial repentance, or merely regretting consequences?
  
5. Which elements of the redemptive story (creation, fall, redemption, restoration) are visible in this chapter?
  
6. How does this chapter inform the way you should view and reach out to the world around you?
  
7. What challenge or encouragement did this passage provide to your soul?
