3. Using Bible tools, what can you find out about the founding of Nineveh? What modern city is probably built at its location?
4. How does the summary of Jonah's message seem to fall short of the full proclamation made by God?
5. How can the citizens of Nineveh's response be condemning of Jonah and Israel?
6. What Hebrew word is repeated in verse 10. (Hint: Our English translations use two different words). How can knowing the words are the same in the Hebrew inform our understanding of the verse?
7. Did God go back on His Word to relent from judging Nineveh? What does God's actions tell us about His character?
