

1. Re-read Exodus 15:22-27. Does chapter 17 just feel like history repeating itself or are there some unique elements? If so, what do you see differently?
2. Search Amalek in a Bible study tool. When does the Lord commission their full defeat? What ends up happening?
3. What does Paul mean that "the Rock was Christ" (1 Corinthians 10). What connection is Paul making. (We're cutting you one question short this week so you can really dwell on this one!)
4. Which elements of the redemptive story (creation, fall, redemption, restoration) are visible in this chapter?
5. How does this chapter inform the way you should view and reach out to the world around you?
6. What challenge or encouragement did this passage provide to your soul?
