2. "We Fall" • How do we regularly fail to obey this command? What illustrations can you think of from Scripture?
  
3. "Jesus Yeah!" • How did Christ perfectly obey this command? Can you think of Scriptures that illustrate when He was tempted not to, yet was without sin?
  
4. "We Obey!" • As His children, how can we now obey this command positively, and not just avoid committing a violation of the command?
  
5. Martin Luther said that if you break commandments 2-10, it shows you've already broken commandment 1. What do you think he meant by that? Do you agree?
  
6. How can we speak of idolatry in such a way as to call nonbelievers to follow Christ?
