2. "We Fall" • How do we regularly fail to obey this command? What illustrations can you think of from Scripture?

3. "Jesus Yeah!" • How did Christ perfectly obey this command? Can you think of Scriptures that illustrate when He was tempted not to, yet was without sin?

4. "We Obey!" • As His children, how can we now obey this command positively, and not just avoid committing a violation of the command?

5. Paul says this is the first command with a promise (Ephesians 6). Why do you think that matters?

6. How can we speak of parenting and children in such a way as to call nonbelievers to follow Christ?
