

1. "God's Law" • What attributes of God are revealed in this command? Can you think of New Testament passages that support this?

2. "We Fall" • How do we regularly fail to obey this command? What illustrations can you think of from Scripture?

3. "Jesus Yeah!" • How did Christ perfectly obey this command? Can you think of Scriptures that illustrate when He was tempted not to, yet was without sin?

4. "We Obey!" • As His children, how can we now obey this command positively, and not just avoid committing a violation of the command?

5. After getting beat up by the first five commandments, most people feel like they've safely avoided this one. How does Jesus blow that view up?

6. How can we speak of murder in such a way as to call nonbelievers to follow Christ?
