



1. What does Paul mean that “each will have to bear his own load” (Galatians 6:5). Does this feel contradictory to Galatians 6:2?
2. Take a look at the picture of the body encouraging and being encouraged by one another in suffering from 2 Corinthians 1:3-11. How does it model how we can care for one another?
3. How does Cain’s apathy toward his own sin effect his attitude toward others? (Genesis 4:1-16)
4. How can the truth of 1 Corinthians 10:13 both encourage us of our personal responsibility to endure, but of mutual encouragement that we can find?
5. Paul affirms we are individuals, but also a part of a larger body in 1 Corinthians 12:14-31. What distortions of the gospel happen if we deny either of these realities?
