1. The beginning section of chapter 8 has brackets around it. Why? Do you think anything is lost or gained by this particular passage?
2. Looking back to 7:45 on, it seems there is a lot of "legal, court talk." How do the Pharisees words/actions show hypocrisy in their demands toward Jesus?
3. What attributes/information does this passage give you about Jesus the Light?
4. Why would Jesus claiming to be the Light be startling? (Isaiah 42:6, Isaiah 49:6, Malachi 4:2)
5. What particularly challenged/convicted/strengthened/encouraged you from this passage?
