1. Read Psalm 102 and create a summary statement for the Psalm.
2. Read Psalm 110 and create a summary statement for the Psalm.
3. Psalm 110:1 is the most quoted Old Testament verse found in the New Testament. Search for the times it is used in the New Testament. How is it used? How can this help us understand the Psalm better?
4. How is the purpose of Jesus contrasted with the purpose of angels?
5. How does Jesus' infinite nature (both before creation and into eternity) display his eternal nature?
6. How did this week's study convict, comfort or provide you with assurance?
7. See the forest AND the trees. From our individual studies in Hebrews 1, how do you see them working together toward one theme?
