4. Verse 8 says all things are in subjection but we do not see everything in subjection to Him. What does that look like? How do you explain it?
5. Is verse 9 teaching that everyone goes to heaven? How do you explain this verse?
6. How can this passage inform the way you seek to serve others?
7. What conviction, comfort or assurance did you find in this week's study?
