1. Read Psalm 22 and create a summary statement for the Psalm.
2. How many different Psalms have we quoted so far in Hebrews? Why do you think the author is quoting so much from one book of the Old Testament?
3. Read Isaiah 8 and create a summary statement for the chapter.
4. Why isn't Jesus ashamed of us? How should this change the way we think and live?
5. Is this passage saying Jesus wasn't perfect until after the cross? What's a better way to understand this verse?
6. How does Christ's work over all creation make it fitting that he would also be our source of salvation?
7. What conviction, comfort or assurance do you find from this week's study?
