4. If the Bread and the Cup looked to the past, and foot washing spoke to our present, how does celebrating a Marriage Feast point toward the future?
5. How can a Marriage Feast help illustrate gospel truth?
6. How does a three-fold communion point to the different aspects of the gospel?
