2. Read Numbers 16. Why is it important that the high priest is appointed and doesn't claim that role for himself?
3. How should the attitude of Galatians 6:1-5 have been present in the Old Testament priesthood as well?
4. In the Old Testament system, who serves as the priest for the High Priest? How is this flawed?
5. How can this passage encourage us that we can still minister to others, even though we struggle with sin?
6. How does Christ's sinlessness provide a far greater ministry to us?
7. What conviction, comfort or assurance did you find in this passage?
