HEBREWS 5:7-10 • MAY 26

LIFEgroup questions

1. Read Psalm 22 and create a summary for this Psalm.
2. Why is it significant, not just that Jesus prayed, but that He did so with loud cries and tears?
3. Why would some people be tempted to believe Jesus' prayers were not heard? How can this help us define "answered prayer?"
4. What does it mean that Jesus "learned obedience" and "being made perfect?" Does this teach something other than the sinlessness of Jesus?
5. What does it mean to obey Jesus? What would you say to someone who says that sounds like "salvation by works?"
6. Since next week is kind of a transition passage, go ahead and summarize the message of Hebrews 5 this week, remembering to explain how it fits into the larger theme of the entire book.
7. What conviction, comfort or assurance can you find in this passage?
