1. What kind of things are testified about (bear witness) in 3 John?
2. Who are you really supporting when you support someone for gospel purposes? (Matthew 25)
3. Why does the author of Hebrews say hospitality is important? (Hebrews 13)
4. In what way do these "strangers" help you and I fulfill the Great Commission? (Matthew 28)
5. What does John mean that these men would not receive support from Gentiles? Does he mean they only received support from Jews, or does he mean something else?
6. John says we should "support such men" in verse 8. That same word is also used in Acts 1:9 to describe the cloud during Christ's ascension. How does that imagery help you understand what John means by support?
7. What should be our desired outcome for these men, by supporting them?
