1. Before reading any other texts, simply read through Leviticus 19. What is your impression of the chapter? Are these sins a temptation? What are your thoughts about people who would sin in these ways? Record your initial thoughts.
2. Where has Israel seen these violations?
3. How did the forefathers violate these laws? (Genesis 20, 29 & 38) How could these guys be forgiven?
4. Did these things cease to be a temptation by the New Testament? (Matthew 14; 1 Corinthians 5)
5. What sexual sins does Paul renounce in Romans 1? What is your attitude toward these sins?
6. Reread the passage in Romans 1, what other sins does he renounce? Does your attitude from question 5 match your attitude about these sins?
7. What should our attitude toward sexual sin be? (1 Corinthians 6)
8. Review your answer to question one. Has your attitude changed any?
