3. What deformities/blemishes prohibit a priest from participating in sacrifices? May he eat of the sacrifices?
4. What is a priest prohibited from if he is unclean?
5. What sort of offerings would not be acceptable before the Lord?
6. What are the consequences of an unacceptable offering, either by priests blemish or the offering?
7. How should these things point us to the perfection of Christ?
