1. How is idolatry foundational to this chapter?
2. Do verses 1-13 feel like “works salvation?” How should we understand this passage?
3. How has God perfectly fulfilled verse 11? (2 Corinthians 6)
4. Why would God discipline the Israelites so severely? (Hebrews 12)
5. There are two ways to look at this passage. A) God presents a hypothetical situation, which through the disobedience of Israel, eventually becomes fulfilled in the exile. B) God, decreeing in advance that He would place Israel in exile speaks of His judgment in advance. How does either view effect your understanding of God?
6. Will people choose to follow God when placed in relative paradise? (Revelation 20)
7. What does this tell us about the nature of humanity?

3. How does this passage help transform me more into the image of Christ?
