4. What did David understand about the cost of a burnt offering? (1 Chronicles 21)
5. How does Jesus assess the value of an offering? (Mark 12)
6. What example has God given us of a costly offering? (2 Corinthians)
7. How should the believer respond today? How much should we offer? (Romans 12)
