1. What effect does the anointed priest's sin have on the people? Why would this be?
2. What could a sin of the whole congregation look like? Why would it carry such a heavy load? (Joshua 9)
3. What does the differing value for the sacrifices suggest? What does this suggest about the difference between the anointed priest, the congregation, a leader and the congregation?
4. What could an "unintentional sin" look like? What does the necessity of a sacrifice teach us about the character of God?
5. How is Christ's ministry different than any other priests? (Hebrews 7)
6. How can one be made aware of his/her sin? (Galatians 6; Hebrews 12)
7. How should a believer respond to recognizing "unintentional sin" in his/her life?
