1. Is it wrong to recognize a gift publically? (Philippians 4) What is the flaw of the Pharisees?
2. Is it wrong to pray publically? (John 11) What is the flaw of the Pharisees?
3. How could using the Lord's Prayer in rote be a direct misapplication of Jesus' teaching on prayer?
4. Is it wrong to fast? (Mark 2:18-22) What should be your attitude in fasting? (Isaiah 58)
5. Is it wrong to be rich? What temptations should we be aware wealth can produce? (1 Timothy 6)
6. We often associate "treasures" with money only. However, what other treasures do people store up on earth according to this portion of Matthew 6?
7. In what areas of your walk do you find it tempting to perform for man rather than to pursue Christ?
8. How do you combat this temptation?

1. What unique aspects of Christ are revealed in this passage?
2. What do I have in common with the other persons in this passage?
3. How does applying the gospel to this passage transform me more into Christ's image?
