3. What was Jesus' attitude toward possessions? (Luke 9)
4. Is it wrong to acknowledge our need before God? (Psalm 102) How can we express our need with the right attitude?
5. How should a view of God's sovereignty effect our anxiety? (1 Peter 5)
6. How can anxiety be the evidence of pride?
7. What things cause me to be most anxious?

Ask yourself...

1. What unique aspects of Christ are revealed in this passage?
2. What do I have in common with the other persons in this passage?
3. How does applying the gospel to this passage transform me more into Christ's image?
