5. Who provides the desire to seek Him and the ability to be found? (Jeremiah 29)
6. How should considering others effect the way we pray for myself?
7. How should the gospel inform my prayer life so that I do not hesitate to ask of God, but so I do not turn Him into my "Cosmic Vending Machine" either?
