1. What details does Mark bring out that Matthew neglects? (Mark 2)
2. What details does Luke bring out that Matthew neglects? (Luke 5)
3. Why do you think Matthew would neglect these details? What central point does he want to keep free from distraction?
4. Whose faith was Jesus impressed with?
5. How is the power of Christ seen in His spoken word? How is this also true of our salvation?
6. What attitude should we have in coming to the Lord? How does Jesus' quote of Hosea illustrate this?
7. What does the account of the paralytic and the account of Matthew's calling have in common?

Ask yourself...

1. What unique aspects of Christ are revealed in this passage?
2. What do I have in common with the other persons in this passage?
3. How does applying the gospel to this passage transform me more into Christ's image?
