How does the gospel cease to be good news, if a person affirms a "spiritual resurrection" for Jesus but denies the bodily resurrection of Jesus?

Why do you think some people find a bodily resurrection hard to believe in? How do you think this became a popular teaching in Corinth?

It's possible that some were teaching that a true believer wouldn't die until Christ returned. If this was true, then what would that say about believers who had died already. I don't think anyone is teaching that 2,000 years later, but how can our teaching/preaching become focused only on this life here/now, and not in light of eternity? In what ways can our faith become overly focused only on this world, right now?

In what ways is the resurrection vital in our being forgiven of our sins?

Did this passage correct, convict, equip or encourage you? In what way?
