Why were the people of the Gerasenes region afraid and asked Jesus to leave after He had healed the demon-possessed man (Luke 8:35-37)?

How can the story of the healed man in Luke 8:38-39 inspire us to share our own experiences of God's work in our lives?

Does this passage challenge, encourage, correct, or teach you more about the beauty of the gospel?

Do you see any connections to Psalm 69 in the Luke passage? If so, what? How can this Psalm inform the way we can pray for one another?
