Paul does not seem to be worried about people-pleasing, yet he’s very concerned about not causing offense? Where is that line? How do we navigate it?

Do you think 11:1 is a unique statement only an apostle could make, or do you think it is appropriate for us to say it to others? Why or why not?

Did this passage correct, convict, equip or encourage you? In what way?

PRAYING THE PSALMS. Pray through **Psalm 119:121-128** (the theme word is “done”). How did you notice this theme in the rest of this section? How did you see your life circumstances and this section intersecting?
