4. Is Elijah really "alone" as the only prophet of the Lord? What does he mean?
5. How can we know that it was not simply a lightning strike that hit the altar?
6. Once the storm began, what actions suggest that Elijah may have thought the battle was over?
7. How are we tempted to divide our faith? How, as believers, are we still tempted to worship idols? How can we help each other worship Christ alone?
