



**Restoration:** When Jesus returns, He will rid the world of sin, the curse and evil. Some distort this into a fatalism that doesn't engage the world. But let's use the grid of Colossians 3:17 ("Whatever you **do** in word or deed, do all in the **name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks** through Him to God the Father) to consider how lives effected by the compassion of Christ should compassionately seek to make the world a better place.

Read Galatians 6:6-10 to help answer the following questions:

1. How does Paul describe the day of judgment?
2. What does it mean to sow to the Spirit?
3. Who should our good works effect?
4. What wrong motivations can a person have while helping people?
5. Why should we serve others? How should that affect the way we serve?
6. How can you help a person suffering because of sin (their own or others)?
7. How can we meet physical needs without neglecting the gospel?
8. What do you say to a person who refuses to meet needs because they want to "just focus on the gospel?"
9. How can you give thanks when you find yourself in need?
10. How can you give thanks while giving to the needs of others?
