Earlier in Acts 1, it says that Jesus had been teaching the disciples for 40 days. How does their question in verse 6 help reveal a bit about what He was teaching?

Jesus' response could feel dismissive unless we realize He has consistently taught that they will not know the time of His coming. How has he already prepared them to think about His establishing of the Kingdom? (Mark 13:32-36)

Compare and contrast this Great Commission in Acts with the previous ones we have looked at. How do you explain the differences/similarities?

When will this no longer be the charge of Jesus' disciples? Has that day come yet?

What did you notice in this passage that you had not seen before?

How does the gospel convict or encourage you as you seek to apply this passage?

How can your LIFEgroup pray or encourage you?
