Do you think Nebuchadnezzar would be excited to hear this dream (and explanation) or angered? Why?

Do the nations appear to be getting stronger or weaker over the course of the dream? How might this speak to our view that society is getting better and stronger and advancing over time?

Where is the USA in this dream? How should that knowledge change what our perspective on history should be? How should it change some of our expectations about the future too? How can this help calm some anxieties about our election?

What makes Christ's Kingdom unique to all other earthly kingdoms?

Some people misuse Daniel 2:43 to speak against interracial marriage. What Scriptures would you use to show this isn't the point in the dream?

Daniel's prophecies are so detailed (and so accurate) that many people claim they were not written by Daniel, but were written after the fact. How would you answer them?

If you were given a detailed dream of your own rise and fall, how do you think you would handle it? What would change for you?
