Look back through the chapters of Daniel so far. How else have we seen that Daniel is committed to prayer?

How does this passage reveal God exacting justice without Daniel enacting vengeance?

What was the king's attitude toward Daniel's fate? What does this say to us about their relationship?

The den is sealed with a stone. Obviously, this is a foreshadow to the resurrection. How does Daniel's arrest and "execution," along with his deliverance point us toward Jesus?

How does the irreversible nature of Medo-Persian decrees work for and/or against Daniel, the king and the men who conspired against Daniel?

From here, we begin to examine the visions that Daniel has. How would you summarize Daniel's relationship to kings and position as an exile from Daniel 1 through Daniel 6?
