

DANIEL 7:13-28 ~ March 7, 2021

Ezekiel used the term "son of man" as a way to simply speak of humanity. How is it obvious in this vision that "Son of man" is being used differently?

The kingdoms of this earth can make us alarmed and anxious. The angel does not tell Daniel to withdraw from them, but what counsel does he offer? How does this counsel serve us today?

Many scholars believe the fourth beast is Rome. What parallels from the vision can you find to the Roman Empire?

Yet, the fourth beast is different from all the others. How could this vision be speaking beyond 476AD (or whenever you want to mark the fall of the Roman Empire)?

Many people have sought to connect "the horn" with various historical figures. Others have said this must be a prophecy of the Antichrist. Could both be right? (1 John 2:18-25)

How can this passage serve to encourage your walk with Christ?
