

DANIEL 9:1-19 ~ May 2, 2021

Consider Jeremiah 25. How difficult should it be to discern the number of years in captivity? What does this suggest to us about our ability to easily discern truth when we are right in the middle of a situation?

The book of Daniel does not record a single sin of Daniel's. Why do you think he uses "we language" in his prayer of confession?

The Mosaic Covenant contained blessings for obedience and curses for disobedience. What curses were fulfilled in the time of captivity (Deuteronomy 28)?

From Daniel's prayer, how would you say Israel has responded to the discipline of the Lord? What can we learn from this?

How does Daniel's reference to the Exodus serve as transition toward hope? What parallels are there to the Exodus and to Israel's eventual return to the Promised Land?

How does this passage provide gospel hope for you?

Psalm 93

Read the Psalm and consider the following questions.

What does this Psalm teach us about God?

What does this Psalm teach us about ourselves?

How does this Psalm show us our need for a savior?

How does this Psalm lead us toward hope in God?
