Read the list again from 27-29. How does it make you feel to read this description? How can this message be good news?

What was the message of Paul's preaching in Corinth? Compare it to what he says about his preaching in Ephesus in Acts 20:27. Do you think he preached different main themes?

We don't think of Paul as a guy to trembled and feared. Reread Acts 18 to see why he may have. What kind of things cause you to be afraid when sharing the gospel?

What can happen to our faith if it is tied to the preacher and not the message? Have you ever done this? Have you seen it happen to others?
