Read verses 8:1-10. How does salvation transform the way we respond to the flesh?

How does being set free from fear transform the way we relate to one another?

Jesus isn't mentioned in this paragraph. However, how is our union with Christ essential for this passage?

How can suffering cause relationships to grow deeper?

How does inheritance speak to our relationship with God and with one another?

Values flow from our identity, not the other way around. (As family, we relate NOT we relate to become family.) How does this passage help reinforce that proper order?
